

AAPP Sponsorship of Events

The AAPP has a budget for sponsorship of scientific conferences or workshops, which is of order \$50K per year. However, the available budget may be adjusted over a number of years depending on the number of sponsorship requests received.

Applications for conference/workshop support can be made at any time but must demonstrate the benefit your event will deliver in line with AAPP research. It is considered useful if AAPP researchers could make applications for support for a period of 2-3 years in advance so that the budget allocation can be ranked and prioritised.

Sponsorship criteria

Sponsorships should possess the following common core criteria:

- Appropriate activity alignment with AAPP core research (involvement of at least 2 AAPP Projects and partner agencies)
- Value of opportunities for networking
- Co-sponsorship

Procedure

A sponsorship proposal form should be completed online for all requests.

The AAPP Program Leader approves all AAPP sponsorship proposals.

Acknowledgement

All sponsorship from the AAPP must be acknowledged as follow:

This conference/workshop received grant funding from the Australian Government as part of the Antarctic Science Collaboration Initiative program. The Australian Antarctic Program Partnership is led by the University of Tasmania, and includes the Australian Antarctic Division, CSIRO Oceans and Atmosphere, Geoscience Australia, the Bureau of Meteorology, the Tasmanian State Government and Australia's Integrated Marine Observing System.

The AAPP logo should be used in conference/workshop promotional materials, such as flyers, websites, etc. as well as all partner agencies' logos.

Reporting

A report of the conference/workshop should be provided to the AAPP Office within 1 month after the event, outlining the benefits and outcomes achieved. The details should also be reported in the Cle(v)er reporting tool. Failure to submit a final report will influence requests for further sponsorship support by the relevant AAPP project(s).
